Directions to the workshop:

From The South:

Take **101 North** to 880 South toward Los Gatos/ Santa Cruz. In 1.9 miles take The Alameda exit toward Santa Clara University. Take the first Left Newhall St. and the next left on to Morse Street and park in the parking lot to the left across the street from the Hall. The neighbors prefer us parking in the lot over parking on the street in front of the houses.

Or go **280 North** to 880 North toward Oakland. In 2.3 miles take The Alameda exit Left toward Santa Clara University. Take the first Left Newhall St. and the next left on to Morse Street and park in the parking lot to the left across the street from the Hall. The neighbors prefer us parking in the lot over parking on the street in front of the houses.

From The North:
