From Highway 101, take the Blithedale/Tiburon exit. Turn west onto E. Blithedale. Drive for 1.8 miles to downtown Mill Valley. Turn left onto Throckmorton Avenue and travel 0.2 miles. The church is on the corner of Olive Street and Throckmorton.

Mill Valley has free street parking north and west of the church. (Check street signs.) Meters don't operate on Saturday on Throckmorton and other streets, but posted time limits apply.
