### **BY CAR:**

#### **From the North:**

**Walnut Creek:** Take 24 to 880.

**Marin:** Take the Richmond - San Rafael Bridge to 580 South. 580 turns into 80. Follow signs to 880.

**San Francisco:** Take the SF-Oakland Bay Bridge to 880 South (Alameda/San Jose).

**Sacramento:** Take I-80 to 880 South (Alameda/San Jose)

Take the Hegenberger exit.  
(toward Oakland Airport)

#### **From the South:**

Take 880 North.

**Penninsula:** Take the Dumbarton Bridge and 92 East to 880 North (Oakland).

Take the Hegenberger/Coliseum exit.  
Left onto Edes and left onto  
Hegenberger Road.

#### **From Pleasanton/Livermore Area:**

Take 580 West to 238 to 880 North  
(Oakland). Take the  
Hegenberger/Coliseum exit. Left onto  
Edes and left onto Hegenberger Road.

### **BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:**

**BART:** Exit at the Coliseum/Oakland Airport Station. Take the 50 Bus to the stop in front of the Holiday Inn.
