From the North:

Walnut Creek: Take 24 to 880.

Marin: Take the Richmond - San Rafael Bridge to 580 South. 580 turns into 80. Follow signs to 880.

San Francisco: Take the SF-Oakland Bay Bridge to 880 South (Alameda/San Jose).

Sacramento: Take I-80 to 880 South (Alameda/San Jose)

Take the Hegenberger exit.
(toward Oakland Airport)

From the South:

Take 880 North.

Penninsula: Take the Dumbarton Bridge and 92 East to 880 North (Oakland).

Take the Hegenberger/Coliseum exit.
Left onto Edes and left onto
Hegenberger Road.

From Pleasanton/Livermore Area:

Take 580 West to 238 to 880 North
(Oakland). Take the
Hegenberger/Coliseum exit. Left onto
Edes and left onto Hegenberger Road.

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

BART: Exit at the Coliseum/Oakland Airport Station. Take the 50 Bus to the stop in front of the Holiday Inn.
